1. OVERVIEW

This update provides key fixes in the areas of Scripting, Master Pages, Digital Editions, Import/Export Graphics, as well as other miscellaneous issues. (See below for more details.)

This update does not address identified issues running Adobe InDesign CS4 on Mac OS X Leopard (v10.5.1-v10.5.5). Known issues include the following:

- Users are unable to hide InDesign CS4 using the cmd+h keyboard shortcut.
- InDesign CS4 may unexpectedly quit when using the Place, Save, Save As or Export commands using either the OS or Adobe dialog boxes.

To address these issues, download Mac OS X Leopard v10.5.6 or later from Apple's web site. For more information on how to upgrade your operating system, please refer to <http://www.apple.com/downloads>.

InDesign CS4 6.0.2 includes the cumulative fixes from InDesign CS4 6.0.1 (posted February 2009). Any new fixes are marked with an asterisk (*).

3. INSTALLATION NOTES

Please make sure that the InDesign application is shut down in advance of running the InDesign updater (at least 1 minute recommended).

4. RESOLVED ISSUES

This section provides a list of the resolved technical problems included as part of the InDesign CS4 6.0.2 update. Note that these issues are stated as the original problem statement, and not the corrected behavior. Digital Editions

Content is dropped during export to Digital Editions when two or more documents are included in a book. [2262891]*

Export for Digital Editions will put underscores, rather than spaces, in the Contents if TOCStyle is not used. [2296603]*

Bold (and in some cases italic) won't work when exporting an InDesign document to Digital Editions. [2296606]

Exporting to Digital Editions fails with an error in the Italian and French version. [1923992]

Documents

File type information for InDesign CS4 shows as IDd5 instead of IDd6 (Mac only). [2265758]*

InDesign unexpectedly quits when joining two points with the pen tool. [2249066]

InDesign unexpectedly quits when Shift-Command-double-clicking to override a master page text frame containing text. [1912742]

InDesign unexpectedly quits when user clicks in the Links panel. [1926360]

InDesign documents with a large number of placed InDesign files may fail to update the links to the placed InDesign files. [1919796]

When placing InDesign CS3 snippets, incx files and library assets into an indd document, the application may improperly import the XML backing store. [1903461]

Export Graphics

When using Export to JPEG with the High or Maximum quality settings, the actual quality of the resulting file is lower than expected. [2286669]*

JPEG quality preference has no effect in SWF export. [2271113]*

Page turns are incorrect for right-to-left bound documents exported to SWE. [1903415]

When exporting a document to .SWF, “mailto:” links have “http://” appended to them making them inoperable. [1932353]

InDesign document with very large images with a high effective resolution fails to export to PDF. [1927881]

Photoshop clipping paths drop out for certain placed EPS's unless “Read Embedded OPI Image Links” is chosen in Import options. [1903458]

Master Page Items from a placed InDesign document are dropped when exporting to PDF. [1916049]

Import Graphics

Drop shadow on object that resides on a master page drops out if that .indd is placed into another .indd file and then either exported to PDF or printed. [1932134]*

Scripting

PageNumberStyle scripting property does not support string type, leading to potential incompatibility with Middle Eastern version IDML files. [1899219]

Tables

Stroke settings for merged table cells get lost when opening an INX file created in InDesign CS3 or earlier. [1927097]

Text

InDesign unexpectedly quits when importing certain Word files. [2256271]*

InDesign unexpectedly quits when applying italics to a mix of text which includes a font without an italic face. [2272770]*

When Regular is selected for the Kinsoku Hang type, and there are punctuation marks and TCY on the same line, the non-TCY text can be positioned incorrectly. [2300769]*

InDesign CS3 documents converted to InDesign CS4 reflow unexpectedly due to hyphenation limits. [1893957]

InDesign unexpectedly quits when drawing a page with a <Running Header> text variable, if Show Hidden Characters is enabled. [1914144]

InDesign unexpectedly quits when selecting a URL entered in user dictionary. [1927020]

UI

On older Windows machines, .png images may fail to display. [1922914]

Print

Text with Ruby causes an error in Preflight. [2275029]*

With flattening on, an unexpected quit occurs when printing a page with a PICT that has a drop shadow or other transparency applied. [1934247]*

Prepress

Flattener Preview incorrectly calculates area of transparency for outer effects applied to text. [2272674]*

Page Items

Object Style does not pick up certain opacity settings of another Object Style that it is based on, specifically its fill, stroke or text opacity. [2290380]*

INX

Image file names/paths are not retained when a doc is opened in InDesign CS3, if the image was missing when the INX was created from InDesign CS4. [2265833]*

Image dragged from a library while its associate asset is missing will appear to be up to date, but export as a gray box if the same image was previously placed in the doc. [1900005]*

PDF Import

Placing a PDF with malformed JBIG2 data causes the application to unexpectedly quit. [2294110]*

Layout

Unexpected quit when duplicating a page that has an overridden and deleted master page item. [2285797]*

Links panel is slow when using 1000s of links. [2277944]*

Documents containing a linked file with a forward slash in their file name fail to package. [2278761]*

InDesign CS4 will fail to convert/open CS3 documents with placed InCopy files containing tags in deleted text. [2275056]*

Architecture

Document containing hundreds of text frames and custom baseline grids takes a long time to open and causes an “out of memory” error, followed by an unexpected quit. [2253219]*

Unexpected quit when clicking on sample button with the vertical frame grid tool. [1899123]*

5. RESOLVED ISSUES FOR DEVELOPERS

This section provides a list of the resolved technical problems included as part of InDesign CS4 6.0.2 that are primarily of interest to developers.

Before/after import event handlers are not getting called when importing XML. [2286475]*

Developers cannot debug Flash-based UIs hosted in InDesign. [2298280]*

When using FlexUIStroke SDK sample, the keyboard focus may get lost. [1929603]*

Paragraph composer may get stuck in an infinite loop during the execution of JavaScripts that repeatedly modify stories in different documents. [2285007]*
